at the corner of Heyward Street and Briggs Avenue, being known and designated as Lot Nos. 118 and 118-1/2 on Plat of Property of Greenville Trust Company which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, page 177, reference to which Plat is hereby made for a more complete description.

These are the same lots of land conveyed to T. W. Barr and L. L. Barr by Elza B. Hamilton and Annie J. Hamilton by deed dated November 2, 1912, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 21, page 354. Said T. W. Barr died leaving of force his last will and testament found in Apartment 119, File 29 of the Office of Judge of Probate for Greenville, S. C., under which his interest in said lands passed to Ella D. Barr. Said L. L. Barr died leaving of force his last will and testament found in Apartment 295, File 17 in the Office of Judge of Probate for Greenville County, S. C. under which his interest passed to Marie D. Barr for life, and after her death to his children Annie Barr Anderson, Julius M. Barr, Alice Barr (now Alice Barr White), Elizabeth Barr, and Louis Lee Barr, said Marie D. Barr has since died.
