being tract #3 of the Robert A. Means, (deceased), lands, and a portion of the land conveyed to J. E. Means and R. A. Means, May xx, 1929, and according to survey made by W. A. Hester, March 1929, having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on Leigons Bridge Road, corner of Tract #4, of the R. A. Means lands and running thence with said Leigons Bridge Road in a Southeasterly direction 14.20 chs. to point in said road; thence in a Northeasterly direction to a stake in Whitehorse Road; thence with said White Horse Road N. 28 W. 12.68 chs. to bend in said road; thence with said bend N. 27 W. 5.80 chs. to stone in said White Horse Road; thence S. 86 1/2 W. 2.00 chs. to stone, corner of Tract #4 of said R. A. Means lands; thence with line of tract #4, S. 19 1/2 W. 15.58 chs. to the beginning corner, containing 16.6 acres, more or less.

This being the same property as that conveyed to R. A. Means, Jr., by deed of J. E. Means and R. A. Means bearing date of May 18th, 1929, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 148 at page 99.
