

POWER OF ATTORNEY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, William Frank Beck of Greenville, South Carolina do by these presents hereby make, constitute and appoint my sister Mrs. Delphene Pearson, 64 Brooks Avenue, Union Bleachery, Greenville, South Carolina, to be my true and lawful agent and attorney in fact, for me and in my name, place and stead,

1. To demand, sue for, and receive all debts, moneys, securities for money, good chattels, legacies, or other personal property to which I am now or may hereafter become entitled, or which are now or may become due, owing, or payable to me from any person or persons whomsoever, and in my name to give effectual receipts and discharges for the same.

2. To pay or deposit moneys in my name, or otherwise, with any bank, banker, broker, or other agent.

3. To receipt any bill of exchange, check, or order, or any promissory note or other negotiable paper, payable to me, or to indorse or negotiate the same in my name; and also in my name to accept any draft or bill of exchange which may be drawn upon me in relation to the matters aforesaid committed or intrusted to my said attorney.

4. To commence, prosecute, or enforce, or to defend, answer, or oppose, all actions or other legal proceedings touching any of the matters aforesaid, or any other matters in which I am or may hereafter be interested or concerned; and also to submit to judgement in any such action or proceeding.

5. And generally to act as my attorney or agent in relation to the premises, and all other matters in which I may be interested or concerned, and on my behalf to execute all such instruments, and to do all such acts and things, as fully and effectually in all respects as I myself could do if personally present.
