Mary Louise Johnston, her Heirs and Assigns-

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Carolina Avenue and Fairview Avenue in the City of Greenville, S. C. known as Lot No. 19, Block I, Section 5 on plat East Highlands Estate made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, February, 1941 recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County S, C. in Plat Book K at pages 78, 79 and 80 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Carolina Avenue at joint front corner of Lots 18 and 19, Block I and running thence with the line of Lot 18, S. 82-47 W. 206.3 feet to an iron pin on the East side of a five foot strip of land reserved for utilities; thence with the East side of a five foot strip of land reserved for utilities, S. 7-23 E. 70 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Fairview Avenue; thence with the North side of Fairview Avenue N. 82-47 E. 190.3 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the curve of Fairview Avenue to an iron pin on the West side of Carolina Avenue (the chord of which is N. 34-06 E. 32.9 feet); thence with the West side of Carolina Avenue N. 14-35 W. 45.6 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is conveyed subject to the restrictive covenants and buildings restrictions fully set forth in the instrument dated February 26, 1941 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 231 at page 1.
