QUITCLAIM DEED

Office for Greenville County, conveyed to the undersigned "Honour Street Assembly of God Tabernacle, Judson Mill, Greenville, S. C., through its now Board of Trustees, W. D. Christian, Dewey Harmon, and J. A. Allison, their successors and assigns", the lot hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, the correct name of the grantee should have been "Trustees of Assembly of God Church, Southside", (Greenville, S. C.), and it was the intention to so convey said property, and it is desired by this deed to correct the error, now, therefore,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Honour Street Assembly of God Tabernacle, through its now Board of Trustees, W. D. Christian, Dewey Harmon, and J. A. Allison,

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) DOLLARS

to us paid by Trustees of Assembly of God Church, Southside (Greenville, S. C.)

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Trustees of Assembly of God Church, Southside (Greenville, S. C.)

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as Lot No. 10 on plat of property of H. P. Bates made by R. E. Dalton, Eng., and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 32. Reference is hereby craved to said plat for a more particular description of the above mentioned lot, this being Lot purchased by Grace M. Rish from Kate M. Kirkpatrick, Grier Kirkpatrick, and J. W. Kirkpatrick, Jr., as heirs at law of J. W. Kirkpatrick, Sr., deceased, on September 23, 1939, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office, Greenville County, in Book 221 of Deeds, page 293, on May 9, 1940.

This deed is being executed to the grantee herein by the trustees named in the deed by Grace M. Rish, as the trustees of said organization at that time, so that any interest they may have acquired under said deed may be fully transferred and conveyed to grantee herein, their successors and assigns forever.

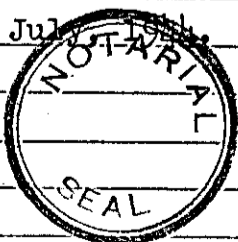
