All that piece, parcel or lot of land in  
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Davis, Grace Lewis Miller, and Elford Alfred Clearance Lewis, all our right, title and interest  
in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of
