H. S. Wood and his heirs and assigns forever.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina on Horse Pen Creek waters of Enoree River and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at a point in center of Horse Pen Creek on line of H. S. Wood and corner of A. J. Wood land at or near the Bridge on Horse Pen Creek on Road leading from Five Forks by Adams Mill and intersecting the Scuffletown Road near new Pelgrim negro church, and running with A. J. Wood land N. 29 1/4 W. .80 to a stone, (Cedar Gone) thence S. 85 W. 1.46 along H. M. Baldwin land 1.46 to a stone; thence S. 51-20 W. along C. S. Templeton land 2.07 to center of horse Pen creek at or near the bend in creek, thence down the meanderings of Said creek to the beginning corner, and containing 1/2 acre more or less.
