in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Lenora T. Burns, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, on the northwest side of Perry Road, and being known and designated as Lot No. 22 and the rear portion of Lot No. 23, of the property of Hext M. Perry, as Trustee, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at page 303, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwest side of Perry Road at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 22, which point is 75 feet northeast of the northeast corner of the intersection of Perry Road and Harrison street, and running thence along the joint line of said Lots, N. 21-02 W. 130 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said lots; thence across the rear of lot No. 23, N. 28-02 W. 48.09 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 24; thence along the line of said Lot No. 24, N. 67-58 E. 46 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 30-00 E. 196.6 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of Perry Road; thence along the line of said Perry Road, S. 43-12 W. 87.7 feet to the beginning corner.
