THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is manufacturing, finishing, converting, buying, selling and generally dealing in and with textile fabrics, and to acquire, construct, establish, conduct and operate, plants, mills, factories and warehouses as may be necessary or expedient in connection therewith; to buy, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge and deal in goods, wares and merchandise and real and personal property of every kind; to do all things incident or necessary to any such business and in general to carry on any business not contrary to the laws of the State of South Carolina and to have and exercise all of the powers, rights and privileges conferred by the laws of the State of South Carolina upon corporations organized thereunder; and also to enter into partnerships with one or more individuals and/or other corporations.
