all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

on the north side of Jamison Street, School District 6-EW, and being known and designated as Lot No. 24, of the property of the American Bank and Trust Company as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 44, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Jamison Street at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 24 and 25, which point is 112 feet east from the northeast corner of the intersection of Jamison Street and Valley Street, and running thence along the joint line of said Lots Nos. 24 and 25, N. 42-43 E. 200 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said Lots; thence S. 53-40 E. 57 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 24 and 23; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 42-43 W. 200 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of said lots on the north side of Jamison Street; thence along the north side of Jamison Street, N. 53-40 W. 57 feet to the beginning corner.
