All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

lying on the western side of the road that leads from the Mt. Lebanon Road to the Jordan Road, being bounded on the north by the said road and lands of J. R. Burton, on the east by lands of D. B. Henson, and on the south and west by lands of R. J. F. Fisher, and being the same tract of land that was conveyed to me by deed from P. F. Cureton December 31st 1917 and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 42 at page 219, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning on an iron pin in the said road (formerly called the Green-Gowansville Road) and on the line of D. B. Henson (formerly Briggs) being the southeast corner of the tract, and runs thence S. 86 1/2 W. 21.00 chs. to an iron pin corner; thence N. 33-56 W. 20.93 chs. to an iron pin on the north side of branch, waters of Middle Tyger River, and on the Fisher line (formerly McKinney); thence N. 83 3/4 E. 22.00 ths. to center of said road; thence with the said road S. 33-00 E. 4.75 chs. to a bend; thence S. 25 1/2 E. 6.33 chs. to a bend; thence S. 31 1/4 E. 10.31 chs. to the beginning corner, and containing Forty (40) Acres, more or less.
