Johnson, H. P. Bonds and W. L. McCarter, as Trustees for Glad Tidings Assembly of God, a religious organization and their successors

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being Lot No. 1 of Block "J", situate on the Southeast corner of Morgan Street (formerly O'Neal Avenue) and Smith Street, having the following metes and bounds according to a plat of City View Land Company made by F. G. Rogers, recorded in Plat Book "A", page 327.

Beginning at a stake on corner of Morgan Street (formerly O'Neal Avenue) and Smith Street and running thence with Smith Street 170 feet to corner of Lot No. 9; thence with line of Lot No. 9, 65 feet to rear corner of Lot No. 2; thence with line of Lot No. 2, 170 feet to corner of Lot No. 2 on Morgan Street; thence with Morgan Street (formerly O'Neal Avenue) 65 feet to the beginning.
