All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

being known and designated as a portion of Lots Nos. 9 and 10 of the Marshall Addition to the City of Greenville as shown by plat recorded in Deed Book 3-E, page 658, and being known and designated, according to a more recent survey of the property of Mrs. G. R. Lampe, as Lot No. 3, as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book "B" at Page 193, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"Beginning at a stake on the Northeast side of the Cedar Lane Road (sometimes called Hampton Avenue Extention), which stake is 126 feet South of the intersection of the Cedar Lane Road and Patterson Street, and running thence N. 53-15 E. 258 feet to a stake; thence S. 35-45 E. 69 feet to a stake, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 4, and running thence with the joint lines of said lots, S. 53-15 W. 258 feet to a stake on the Northeast side of the Cedar Lane Road; thence with said Road, N. 35-45 W. 69 feet to the beginning corner.

Said premises being the same devised to the grantor, who was formerly Maggie Buff, by Will of John T. Buff on file in the Office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County in Apartment 303, File 3.
