on the National Highway, better known as the Camp Road, about three miles from Greenville County Courthouse, known as Lot No. 1 and a portion of Lot No. 2 of the subdivision of a part of the Croft Stone Acres according to plat made by Fitzpatrick-Terry, Engineers, May 6, 1920, having the following courses and distances:

Beginning at an iron pin on the side of the said National Highway at the corner of the property now or formerly owned by G. K.
