All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as Lot No. two (2) of Pride & Patton Land Company, recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "E", at page 249, and, according to said plat, described as follows:

BEGINNING At an iron pin on the north side of Judson Road, corner of Lot No. one (1), and running thence with line of said lot N. 36-15 E. two hundred and eleven (211) feet to an iron pin, corner of Lots Nos. 44, 43 and 1; thence with line of Lot No. forty-three (43), N. 53-45 W. sixty (60) feet to an iron pin, corner of Lots 43, 42 and 3; thence with line of Lot No. three (3), S. 36-15 W. two hundred and eleven (211) feet to an iron pin on Judson Road; thence with Judson Road S. 53-45 E. sixty (60) feet to the beginning corner.

ALSO, a strip of land adjoining the above described lot ten (10) feet in width taken from the west side of Lot No. one (1) on said plat, with a depth in parallel lines of two hundred and eleven (211) feet.
