John P. Lockhart, his heirs and assigns all of our right, title, and interest in and to the pro-
perty of the Estate of David Lockhart, deceased, particularly all that township containing 200
acres more or less, being bounded by Durham and Pennell on the North, by Landrum Water Works
and the Hogback tract on the west, by Pinckney Ballew Estate on the South and on the East by
J. Roy Pennell, all of which is more fully shown by plat made by J. H. Atkins, Nov. 8th, 1913,
to which reference is hereby made. This being part of the property conveyed to David Lockhart
by O. P. Earle and Polly Carruth.

Also, all that tract of land in Greenville County, S. C. in Glassy Mountain Township
containing 65 acres more or less, adjoining the Hogback tract, and being the same property con-
