Marshall Estate, of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville Co, S. C. in Flat Book M, page 85, and according to said plat, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the east side of the White Horse Rd 53-1/3 ft distance from the intersection of the White Horse Rd and Daniel Ave., and running thence a new line S. 80-44 E. 200 ft to a point 53-1/3 ft distance from Daniel Ave in the adjoining line of lots Nos. 22 and 47; thence S. 9-16 W. 53-1/3 ft to a new corner in the adjoining line of lots Nos 23 and 46; thence N. 80-44 W. 200 ft to a new corner on the east side of White Horse Rd; thence N. 9-16 E. 53-1/3 ft to the point of beginning, and being a portion of lots Nos. 22 and 23.
