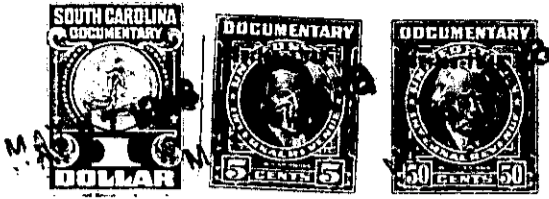

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Joe F. Thomason his Heirs  
and Assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina and just outside the corporate limits of the town of Fountain Inn, with the following metes and bounds, to-wit, according to a plat and survey made by E. E. Gary, Surveyor, May 22, 1948: Beginning at an iron pin, joint front corner with lot of J. W. Pollard, in the eastern edge of sidewalk along Extension of North Main Street, U. S. Highway No. 276, running thence N. 60 1/4 W. along said extension of North Main Street fifty-three (53) feet to an iron pin, joint front corner with other land of the Grantor; thence with line of Grantor N. 31 1/2 E. One Hundred Fifty (150) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 60 1/4 E. Fifty-Three (53) feet to an iron pin, joint back corner with lot of the said J. W. Pollard; thence with line of Pollard S. 31 1/2 W. One Hundred Fifty (150) feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Extension of North Main Street, the point of beginning, and bounded by Extension of North Main Street, other lands of the Grantor and Lot of J. W. Pollard.
