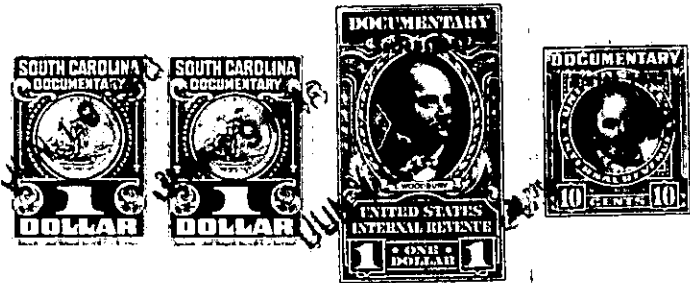

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred and Ninety (\$790.00)

to..... me..... in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by..... Lula Belle Pierce.....  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lula Belle Pierce.....

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in ..... Township,  
County, State of South Carolina. about two miles northwest of Landrum, containing  
7.90 acres, more or less, according to survey and plat made by  
G. W. Pearson, Surveyor, in June, 1948. Said tract of land begins  
at a poplar near branch and runs thence S. 8 E. 217 feet to  
spanish oak; thence S. 6 E. 400 feet to iron pin; thence due south  
250 feet to stake in center of road known as Butter Street; thence  
with the center of the said road crossing creek at 34 feet from the  
last mentioned corner and running N. 51 1/4 E. 521 feet to stake  
in center of road; thence N. 43 1/2 E. 224.5 feet to iron pin in  
center of road; thence N. 8 E. 61 feet to bend in road; thence N.  
21 W. 350 feet to stake in center of road; thence leaving road  
and running S. 66 1/2 W. 14 feet to iron pin on west bank of said  
road; thence S. 66 1/2 W. 241 feet to corner; thence N. 84 W. 25  
feet to another corner; thence N. 68 W. 136 feet to an iron pin;  
thence S. 70 W. 117 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of the lands conveyed to Colby T. Gentry by  
J. J. Gentry, Jr. by deed dated August 25, 1947, recorded in Deed  
Book 319, Page 186. The identical lands here conveyed were cut out  
of that portion of tract number 7 covered by the deed from J. J.  
Gentry, Jr. to Colby T. Gentry.
