COMPLAINT

The plaintiff, complaining of the defendant, alleges and says:

I

That the plaintiff is a resident of Lincoln County, North Carolina, and that the plaintiff has been a resident of the State of North Carolina for more than six months next preceding the institution of this action.

II

That on or about January 29, 1934, the plaintiff and defendant were married in Greensboro, Guilford County, North Carolina, and thereafter lived together as husband and wife until about the 1st day of November, 1945, when the plaintiff and defendant separated, and that since said time there has been a complete separation of plaintiff and defendant as husband and wife; and that no children were born to the marriage union.

III

That the plaintiff and defendant have lived separate and apart from each other since 1st day of November, 1945, which is more than two years, and during all of said time there has been a complete separation of the plaintiff and defendant as husband and wife.

WHEREFORE, the plaintiff prays the Court for judgment dissolving the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the plaintiff and defendant, ~~and for such other and further relief to which he may be entitled.~~
