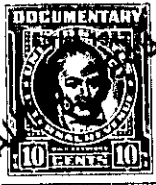

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Samuel A. Few

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in One Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina lying on the east side of the road known as the road between the lands of Grantor and Grantee, the following dimensions containing nine-tenths (0.9) acre, more or less:

beginning in the center of Grantee's road on the north, marked by an iron pin on bank, a corner between Grantor and Grantee, running thence S. 85-40 W. 150 feet to a steel pin; thence N. 44-30 W. 150.4 feet to iron pin; thence N. 40-50 W. 150 feet to point in road, witnessed by walnut tree on bank; thence along road to beginning, S. 44-30 W. 150.5 feet.

This tract is the home site of the old James Mill place and surveyed by W. Hall June 1944.

The above described land is part of the same conveyed to me by Samuel A. Few on the 4th day of November 1944, deed recorded in office Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 276 Page 356
