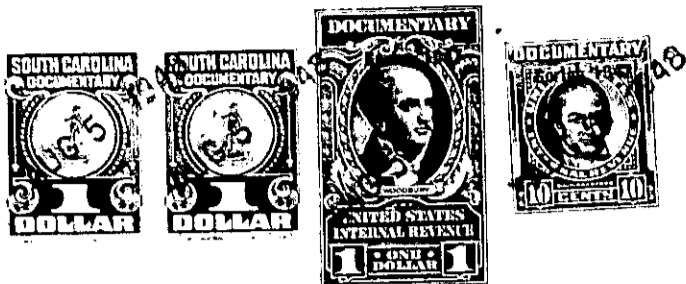

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, near the Town of Marietta, containing 1 1/4 acres, and  
being shown as Lot No. 1 on plat of the property of P. D. Jarrard, made by W. A.  
Hester, Surveyor, July 19, 1944, and having according to said plat the following  
metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the joint corner of property of P. D. Jarrard and  
Slater Manufacturing Company, and running thence with line of Slater Manufacturing  
Company land, N. 68 E. 3.40 chains to stake, corner of lands now or formerly owned  
by Edd Epps; thence with line of Epps' land N. 11 W. 3.70 chains to iron pin on  
branch, corner of Tract No. 2, heretofore conveyed to Emiley W. Burdette; thence  
with line of Burdette land, S. 68 W. 3.40 chains to iron pin in line of other  
property owned by P. D. Jarrard; thence with line of said land, S. 11 E. 3.70
