John O. Vernon, Jr., his heirs and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the northeastern side of Highway 254 from Travelers

Rest to Greenville, being a part of the land known as the land conveyed to Rocy C. Campbell from Jennie Burns by deed recorded in the RMC office for Greenville County in deed book 144 at page 200, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in said Highway, corner of lands now owned by Garrett and running thence N. 41 E., 730.5 feet along the line of said Garrett lands to a point in Pole Branch, iron pin; thence in a southwesterly direction along the center of said Pole Branch, 648.12 feet to a point in said Highway; thence N. 66-15 W., 247 feet along said Highway to the point of beginning; bounded by Garrett on the northwest, Styles on the southeast, and said Highway on the southwest, being triangular in shape and containing 2.32 acres, more or less.
