NOW, Therefore, Know, all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Julia Louise Minus, Daniel M. Minus, Jr. and Eddie Minus,
Lot No. 7: Beginning at a point in the corner of Lot No. 8 and an alley
and running for a distance of approximately 35 feet on said alley to the
corner of Lot No. 6A; thence along line of Lot No. 6A for a distance of
approximately 102 feet; thence S. 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. for a distance of approximately
35 feet to the corner of Lot No. 8; thence along line of Lot No. 8 for
a distance of approximately 130 feet to the beginning corner, there
being situate on said lot a dwelling house.
