HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release  
unto the said W. T. Henderson, Jr.

All the right, title and interest of G. T. Anderson, Jr. the same  
being an undivided one-third interest, in and to the following des-  
cribed real estate:

"All those two certain pieces, parcels, or lots of land situate,  
lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,  
being known and designated as Lots Nos. 40 and 41 of a subdivision known  
as Marshall Forest, according to a survey and plat of the same prepared  
by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, October, 1928, said plat being recorded  
in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, Pages 133 and  
134, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds,
