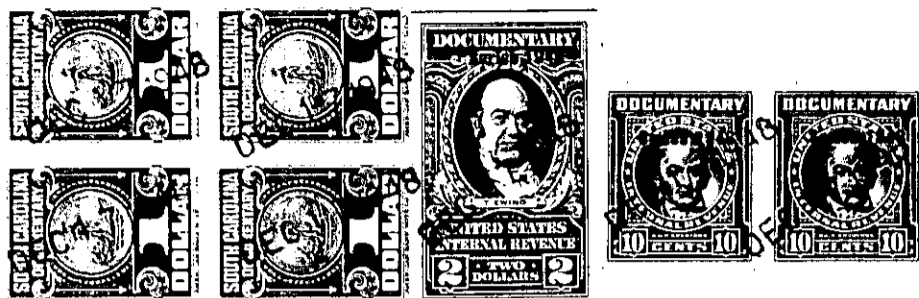

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That I, Joseph S. Shirley
of Greensboro North Carolina
in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Six hundred and fifty
(\$650.00) Dollars
to in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by James L. Swings
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James L. Swings

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,
County, State of South Carolina on the South Side of East Paris Road (Formerly
Blasingame Street) shown as lot number six (6) on R.E. Dalton's
plat of the James P. and Lena C. Yeager land, dated October 1922
boxed in the office of the REC for said County in plat book "F"
No. 141 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and
bounds:

Beginning at a stake on the South side of East Paris Road
(Formerly Blasingame Street) approximately 459 feet eastwardly from
the corner of said road, on the corner of Lot number 7, and running thence
S. 63-30 E. 100.2 feet, more or less, with line of lot number 7 to a
stake on line of property now or formerly belonging to J.A. Davenport's
estate; thence along the Davenport line N. 63-37 E. 60 feet, more
or less, to a stake on the corner of lot number 5; thence N. 26-30
E. 100.2 feet, more or less, along line of lot number 5 to a stake on
the East Side of said road; thence along said road S. 63-30 E. 60 feet, more or
less, to the beginning corner.
