Know all Men by these presents, That We, E. M. Arnold, D. V. Langley and Flora Mae Long, Paul R. Long, Jr., James N. Long and Nannie Belle Long Bridwell, the heirs-at-law of P. R. Long, deceased

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

Six Hundred and No/100 - - - - - (\$600.00) - - - - - Dollars

to us paid by Andrew Webb and Alice Webb

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Andrew Webb and Alice Webb, their heirs and assigns forever:

All those certain pieces, parcels, or lots of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 55 and 56 of a subdivision known as "Parker Heights" according to a plat of the same prepared by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, May, 1946, said plat being recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book P, at page 43, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southeast side of Calhoun Avenue at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 54 and 55, said point being 441 feet from the intersection of Calhoun Avenue and View Point Drive, and running thence along the Southeast side of Calhoun Avenue, N. 30-45 E. 100 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 56 and 57; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 59-15 E. 150 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corners of Lots Nos. 27 and 28; thence along the rear lines of Lots Nos. 28 and 29, S. 30-45 W. 100 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 29 and 30; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 54 and 55, N. 59-15 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described property is a portion of the same conveyed to E. M. Arnold, D. V. Langley and P. R. Long by H. M. Smith by his deed dated October 8, 1945, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 281, page 219.

The grantees are to pay taxes for the year 1949.
