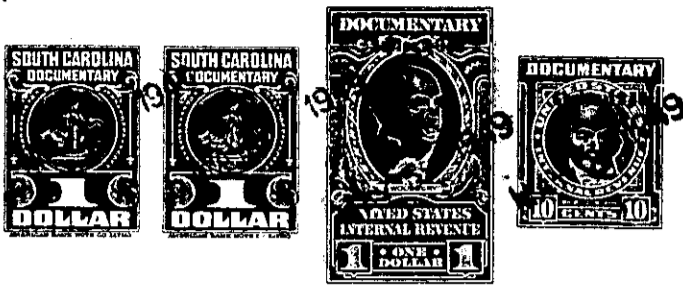

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Robert P. Thornton, his Heirs
and Assigns forever

those pieces, parcels or lots
all that piece or parcel of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as lots Nos. 158, 159
and Southern half of lot No. 157 of the property of Cuttino Heirs
as per Plat made by W. A. Bunn, Engineer, August 1939, recorded
in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "J", page 121,
and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Eastern side of an unnamed street,
said point being in the middle of lot No. 157 and running thence
S. 79-54 E., 258 feet, more or less, to a point on the middle
of rear line of lots Nos. 157 and 173; thence S. 60-15 E., 62½
feet to the joint corner of lots Nos. 159 and 160; thence along
the common line of lots Nos. 159 and 160, N. 79-54 W., 263.5 feet
to an iron pin on the Eastern side of unnamed street above re-
ferred to; thence along the Eastern side of said unnamed street,
62½ feet to the point of beginning.
