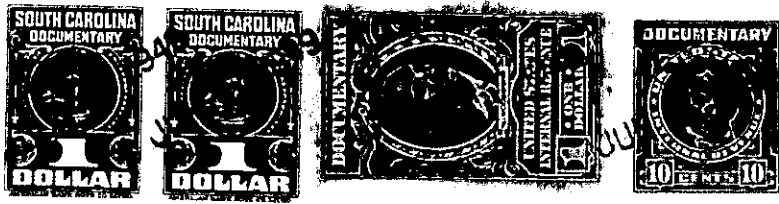

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That We, Floyd Weathers and Mary W. Weathers

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Seventy-Five

us Dollars to in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by N. J. Bloodworth and Roxie B. Bloodworth

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said N. J. Bloodworth and Roxie B. Bloodworth their Heirs and Assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina and near the town of Fountain Inn on the North side of the Jones Mill Road with the following metes and bounds, according to a plat and survey made by E. E. Gary, Surveyor, June 14, 1949: Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of said Jones Mill Road, in the edge of said road, joint front corner with other lands of the Grantors, and running thence with said road S. 17-1/2 W. Eighty (80) feet to an iron pin, corner of other lands of the Grantors; running thence N. 72-1/2 W. One Hundred Fifty (150) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 17-1/2 E. One Hundred Four (104) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 62-1/4 E. One Hundred Fifty-Two (152) feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning, and bounded by lands of the Grantors and the Jones Mill Road.
