in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said First Presbyterian Church of Greenville, South Carolina.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, on the west side of Queen Street in the city of Greenville, between Gower Street and Birnie Street, and having a frontage of 50 feet more or less, on said Queen Street with a depth in parallel lines of 100 feet. The frontage of said lot has been given in the deeds in the chain of title thereto as 50 feet, but the city tax block book shows same as 43 feet. This is the same lot of land conveyed to the grantor by Gladys G. Hack by deed dated October 10, 1941, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 238, page 256.

Grantor is to pay taxes on the above property for 1949.
