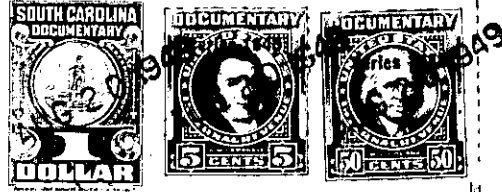

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the S/S of the Dividing Waters Road, about two miles east of the U.S. Highway #25. BEGINNING on eastern corner of the Springfield lot and S/S of Dividing Waters Road, running thence S.  $60\frac{1}{4}$ ° E. along said road 225'; thence S. 27° W. 300' along joint Chandler lot line; thence N.  $61\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 225' to the Springfield lot joint line; thence 27° E. 300' along Springfield line to the Beginning.
