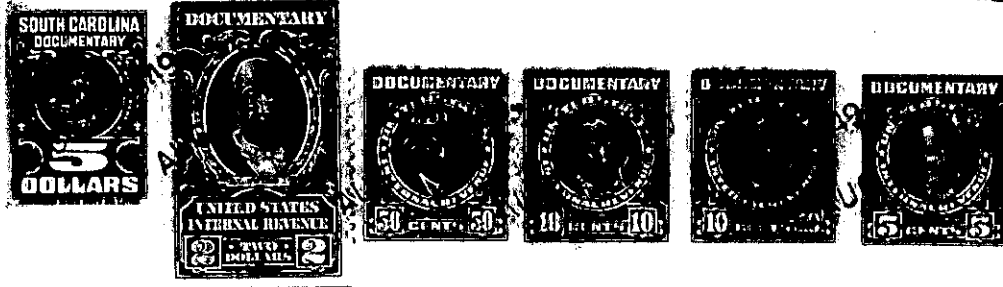

BEGINNING 880 feet (more or less) from the center of
White Horse Road, of the land formerly owned by Mrs Addie R. Ansel, now
owned by E. M. Gilstrap, at an Iron Pin, thence running S. 51-35 ...
approximately 440 feet to iron pin, thence N. 59-30 W. 480 feet to an iron
pin; thence S. 51-35 W. 305 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 50-00 E. 131 feet
to an Iron pin; thence N. 59-00 E. 205 feet to an Iron Pin; thence con-
tinuing along Bramlett Road N. 59-00 E. approximately 651 feet to a
Cherry Tree, thence running in a Northwest direction from the Cherry
Tree to the Iron pin at the beginning point, approximately 250 feet.

The Bramlet road as is now, will be considered and observed as the
Line, in the event the Bramlet road is ever straightened as shown by
above mentioned Plat, then the line will be as above set forth.
