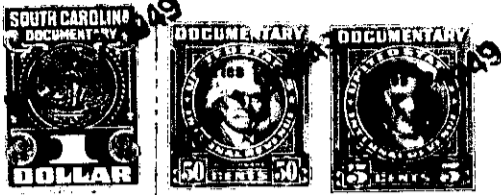

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said U. G. Cantrell, his heirs and  
assigns for ever.

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, being in River Fall Section and containing  
40 acres, more or less, and having the following notes and bounds  
according to a survey made by Patterson, January 24th, 1945 to wit:

Beginning at a stake of pernuma Cantrell Cox corner and running 600  
thence along her line S. 15 E. 36 Chs. to a stake; thence N. 35 E.  
10.00 Chs. to a stake; thence N. 15 E. 28. 00 Chs. to a stake;  
thence N. 85 W. 9.00 chs. to the beginning corner, adjoining lands of  
the said U. G. Cantrell, and others.
