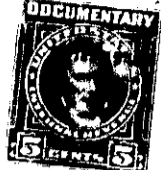
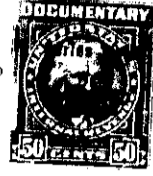

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release

all the right, title and interest of the minor Defeniants, Louise  
Wilson, Shirley Ann Wilson and Bobby Jean Wilson, in and to the follow-  
ing described real estate:
