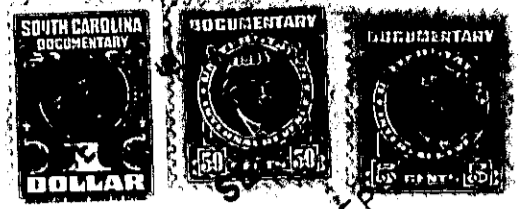

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Louis J. Vaughn all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chicks Springs Township, about two and one-half miles West of Greer, near Fairview Baptist Church, on the West side of Hill Crest Drive, adjoining lands of Landrum J. Vaughn, Louis J. Vaughn and myself, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:- Beginning on an iron pin on Western edge of Hill Crest Drive, Louis J. Vaughn's corner and runs thence with the line of Louis J. Vaughn N. 83-30 W. 450.5 feet to an iron pin on Landrum J. Vaughn's line; thence with this line N. 7-00W. 102.9 feet to an iron pin on said line; thence S. 83-30 E. 463 feet to an iron pin on western edge of Hill Crest Drive; thence with Hill Crest Drive, S. 5-30 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner, containing ONE and 5/100 (1.05) ACRES, more or less.
