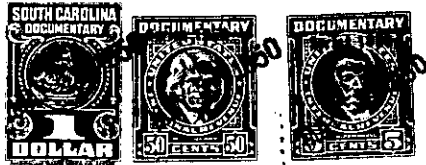

Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Frances G. Trammell, herein called grantor in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five-hundred (\$500.00) and no/100 DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. B. Willis, Jr., herein called grantee, All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on Rutledge Avenue near the City of Greenville, in that section known as Sans Souci in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 114 on plat of property of J. P. Rosamond, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1931, and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book H at Pages 185 and 186 according to deed of J. P. Rosamond to Frances G. Trammell under date of June 22, 1949, recorded in Vol. 388 at Page 381, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an I.P. on the north side of Rutledge Avenue, joint front corners of Lots 113 and 114 and running thence N. 25-15 E. 65' to an I.P., joint front corners of Lots 114 and 115; thence N. 64-45 W. 161.2' to a stake in line of Lot 105; thence S. 22-30 W. 65.1' to a stake; thence S. 64-45 E. 158.1' to an I.P., the point of beginning.



TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
