surgical and acutely ill patients.

Concerning cancer cases I discussed the plan
with Mr. Young of Anderson and Mr. Charles
S. Cameron of N.Y. Director of the Am. Cancer
Society and both approve of its necessity
and feasibility.

Proposed plan would supply beds for
about thirty eight patients including treatment
cases, kidney disorders, diseases of the nervous
system and cancer cases.
