Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Laura Vance Norwood, OLLIE FARNSWORTH in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar ----- DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto

the Most Reverend John J. Russell, Bishop of Charleston, a Corporation sole,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot Number Three (3) as shown on a map or plat of Norwood property made by W.D. Neves, Engineer, May 24, 1920, which map or plat is on file in the office of the Clerk of Court of Common Pleas in Judgment Roll No. 7888, reference to which is hereby expressly made; said lot of land being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the North side of West Washington Street at the corner common to Lots Number Two and Three of said Plat, and running there in a Northerly direction along the dividing line between said Lots Number 2 and 3, One Hundred feet to a stake; thence in a Westerly direction, along a line parallel to West Washington Street, Twenty feet to a stake at the corner common to Lots Number Three and Four as shown on said plat; thence along the dividing line between said Lots Number 3 and 4, in a Southerly direction One Hundred feet to a stake on the North side of West Washington Street; thence along the North side of West Washington Street, in an Easterly direction Twenty feet to the place of beginning.

This is the same lot of land conveyed to Josephine B. Norwood by deed of W.M. Norwood, et al, dated July 1, 1920 and recorded in Deed Book 69 at page 76 and by Josephine B. Norwood to J.J. McSwain, and conveyed by the Executors of his Will to the grantee herein by deed dated October 23, 1950. The purpose of this deed is to vest in the grantee any right, title or claim I may have by reason of the omission of my Dower Renunciation in the deed to Josephine B. Norwood, above.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his successors and assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named and the grantee(s)'s Heirs and assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s Heirs and against every person who may lawfully claim or claim the same in any part thereof.
