C. as Judgement Roll #E-12334, does hereby release and forever discharge from the lien of said judgement, the following described property, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Southwest side of White Oak Way (also known as State Highway No. 291), in School District 270 (formerly 9-C), in Greenville County, S. C., being known and designated as Lot 23 on plat of White Oak Sub-division of the Northside Development Company, prepared by J. D. Pellett, Jr., August 1946, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "P", at page 121, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southwest side of White Oak Way, which stake is N 40-24 W 585 feet from the intersection of Holmes Drive and White Oak Way, and which stake is a common corner of Lots 24 and 23, and running thence with White Oak Way, N 40-24 W 35 feet to a stake; thence still with White Oak Way, N 41-31 W 80 feet to a stake; thence with the line of Lot 22, S 42-17 W 98 feet to a stake; thence with the rear lines of Lots 21 and 20, S 19-29 E 110.3 feet to a stake; thence with the line of Lot 24, N 49-36 E 137.6 feet to the beginning corner.
