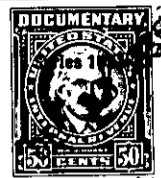

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as lots Nos. 127 and 128 and located on Boling Circle as shown on plat of subdivision of Charlotte A. Tripp known as Brewertown, said plat being made Fitzpatrick-Terry Co., engineers, June, 1920 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "E" at page 254, said property being located just off New Buncombe Road and near Southern Railroad right-of-way, said lots having a frontage on Boling Circle of 25 feet and running approximately 126 feet to lot No. 131 which is the rear boundary; Lot No. 127 is bounded on the South by Lot No. 126 and Lot No. 128 is bounded on the North by Lot No. 129.
