in consideration of the sum of Sixty-Five Hundred and No/100 (\$6500.00) - - - - - DOLLARS,

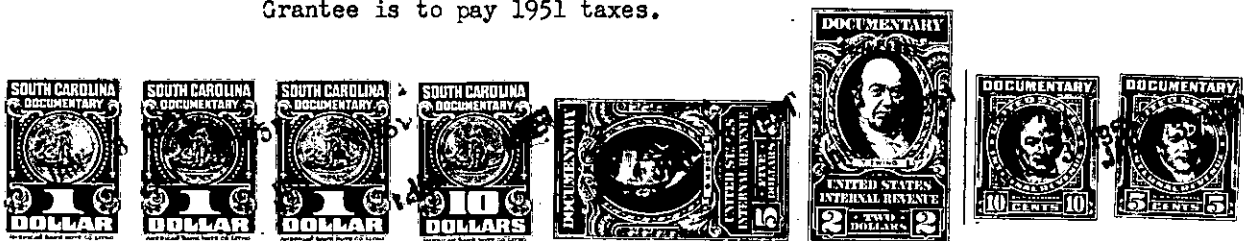
to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Albert E. Mostella, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Northern side of Westbrook Drive (formerly Harmon Drive) and being known and designated as lot No. 15 as shown on a plat of the property of J. E. Harmon, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, May 1941, recorded in Plat Book L at Page 153, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Westbrook Drive, joint front corner of lots 13 and 15, and running thence with joint line of said lots, N. 18-58 E. 205.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 71-00 E. 75 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 15 and 17; thence with joint line of said lots, S. 18-58 W. 205.85 feet to an iron pin in the Northern side of Westbrook Drive; thence with said Drive, N. 71-02 W. 75 feet to the beginning corner.

Being one of the lots conveyed to the grantor by J. E. Harmon by deed dated October 25, 1947, recorded in Volume 325 at Page 56.

Grantee is to pay 1951 taxes.
