have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Nora D. Lollis, her heirs and assigns, forever:

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in School District 2-A in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing Twenty-Two and eight-tenths (22.8) acres, more or less, being Tract No. 2 on a plat from a survey by J. Coke Smith, Surveyor, dated November, 1950, and according to said plat being more particularly described as follows, to-wit: BEGINNING at a point, the common corner of lands this date conveyed to T. R. and Carrie L. Borroughs and lands of Robert Coker Estate; thence S1-30 W 4-18 chains to a stone; thence S 44-00 W 8-15 chains to a point; thence N 19-00 W 31-75 chains to a point; thence N 68-15 E 6-65 chains to a point; thence S 20-25 E 3-76 chains to an iron pin; thence S 23-40 E 20-70 chains to the BEGINNING corner.
