in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Paul L. Webber, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the north side of West Stone Avenue in the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds according to survey made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, October 31, 1925:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of West Stone Avenue, which point is 327.5 feet west of the northwest corner of West Stone Avenue and Townes Street, and running thence N. 5-30 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 84-30 W. 65.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 5-30 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on the north side of West Stone Avenue; thence with the line of said avenue, S. 84-30 E. 65.5 feet to the beginning corner; being the same lot of land conveyed to me by R. H. Holliday by his deed dated October 17, 1947 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 322, at page 497.
