all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, about one mile north from Chick Springs
being east from the St. Mark Road and on the south side of the
road that leads from the St. Mark Road to the Chick Springs
the Old Chick Springs Highway (also known as the Chick Springs
highway, and being a part of the land Chick Springs that was conveyed
to me as recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance
County, in Deed Book 240 at page 276, and being 1/4 of lot 20,
and all of lots 24, 26 and 28 as shown on Plan of Lots 20, 24, 26, 28
Williams made by H. M. Dumas, Surveyor, John Williams,
and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning on an iron pin, joint corner of lots 20 and 21,
which is on the south side of the Chick Springs road,
thence 1/4 mile S. 88-10 W. 270 feet to an iron pin, joint corner
side of the said road (this pin is in the north corner of
of lot 20); thence a new line 145 feet S. 12-15 E. to
S. 88-00 W. 150 feet to an iron pin, joint corner, joint corner
of lots 20 and 22; thence N. 88-00 W. 150 feet to an iron pin,
