Two Hundred Eighty-five (\$285.00) Dollars, in full for a lot of Land in the

Burying Ground of Christ Church, Greenville, numbered 25

in the plat of said Ground, measuring 20 x 30 feet, being the lot conveyed by Christ Church to Haddy Thompson as per deed dated Feb. 17, 1864, viz: "a lot of land in the burying ground of Christ Church, Greenville, S. C., measuring 20 x 30 feet and bounded on the north by Mrs. Dr. Wm. Butler; lot running south to the main avenue and numbered on the plat of the burial ground as No. 25." The north-portion of this lot measuring 18 x 20 feet was conveyed by H. B. Preston Thompson and Cornelia Thompson to Anna M. Earle by deed dated August 18, 1897, and the south portion of this lot measuring 12 x 20 feet was conveyed by H. C. Preston Thompson and Cornelia Thompson to Anna M. Earle by deed dated June 20, 1898.

It is understood and agreed that that portion of the lot occupied by the grave of Lee David Jones shall not be disturbed and that the monument now covering such grave shall not be removed.

Which Lot ~~we~~ do hereby convey to the said J. I. Westervelt

and to his Heirs, for a Burial Place, forever; subject only to such rules

and regulations as the Corporation of said Church may from time to time enact, and to the condition above described concerning the grave of Lee David Jones.
