and their Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

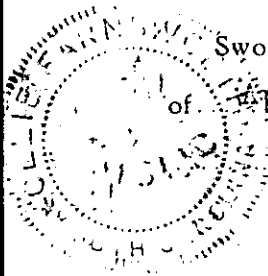
