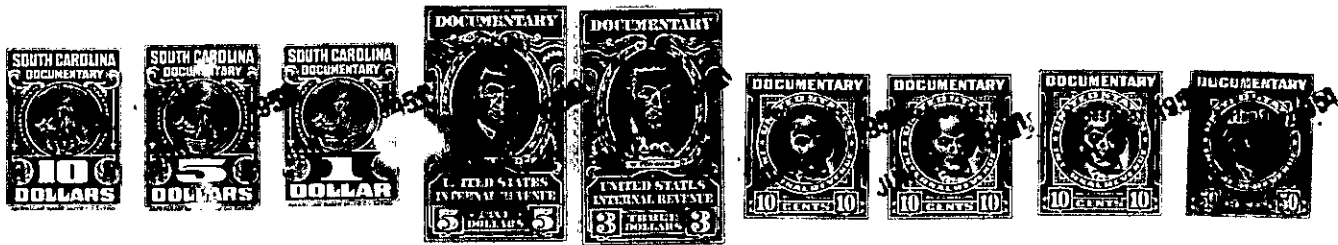

Looper, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that lot of land with the improvements thereon situate on the West side of West Decatur Street, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot 81 on plat of Property of J. P. Rosamond, made by J. E. Rosamond, Engineer, April 1931, being a revision of a plat of Sans Souci Development Co., made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, July 1930, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "H", at pages 185 and 186, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of West Decatur Street, at joint front corner of Lots 80 and 81, and running thence along the line of Lot 80, N 83-45 W 175.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N 11-05 W 62.8 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 82, S 83-45 E 194.2 feet to an iron pin on the West side of West Decatur Street; thence along the West side of West Decatur Street, S 6-15 W 60 feet to the beginning corner.
