(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said....Oscar Lewis McNabb, .....  
all my right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-  
fourth interest in and to the following described real estate:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, on the north side of Saluda River about six miles  
north of the City of Greenville, on the South-west side of Farr's Bridge  
Road, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of the said road, and  
running thence N. 83 W. 2.56 chs. to an iron pin on the south side of  
Saluda River; thence down the said river, following the water line to  
the intersection of the said road, and the said water line, to an iron  
pin; thence with the said road N. 16 1/4 E. 3.00 chains to bend in road; thence  
N. 32 1/4 E. 3.32 chains to the iron pin, the point and place of the begin-  
ning and containing 5/8 of an acre, more or less, and shown by a plat and  
survey of W. A. Hester, dated July 24, 1942. See deed from R. E. Griffin
