All my right, title and interest, the same being a one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$)

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville,
on the East side of David Street and having the following metes
and bounds, to-wit:
