It is further understood and agreed that Farmer shall bear all responsibility and liability for the construction of said line including, but not limited to, any and all liability occasioned by the negligence of Farmer, his servants and agents. It is further understood that Woodfields shall have the right to make and to sell as many taps on said line as it may desire and that this contract shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their respective heirs, administrators, executors, successors and assigns forever.
